



# Kuehn Conservation Area TRAIL MAP

Welcome to the Kuehn Conservation Area, the largest area managed by the Dallas County Conservation Board with nearly 800 acres of forest, recreated prairie and South Raccoon River access.

⚠ The trail map does not include the entire conservation area, but features the region that has developed trails where hunting is **not** allowed.

⚠ Hike safely. Weather conditions can cause slick trails, downed trees and other hazards.

⚠ These trails are designed solely for foot traffic. Hoofed animals and OPDMDs are not permitted.

⚠ All our boundaries are marked with signs. Please respect our neighbors and stay within the boundaries.

⚠ Public restrooms and drinking water are available at the Education Building.

⚠ There are several sites within Kuehn that are sacred to First Nations. Observe all signs that restrict access.

⚠ Register for campground use at the yellow tube near the Education Building.
