Camping Rules and Regulations

Dallas County Conservation Board Adopted (6-12-2012)

- Camping is permitted only in designated areas. Camping is restricted to one basic unit per site except that a tent may be placed on the site with the basic unit. The area occupied by the small tent shall be no more than 8 feet by 10 feet and the tent shall hold no more than four (4) people.
- There are 4 reservable electrical hook-up sites available at Sportsman Park and 4 reservable tent sites at Kuehn Conservation Area. All other campsites are available on a first come/first serve basis only.
- The maximum number of people using a campsite is six (6) except for the following:
 - Families that exceed six persons may be allowed on one campsite if all members are immediate family and cannot logically be split to occupy two campsites.
 - Campsites which are designated as chaperoned, organized youth group campsites.
- Immediate family means spouses, parents or legal guardians, domestic partners, dependent children and grandparents.
- The use of one picnic table per camping unit is permitted.
- Check-in time is 4 p.m. daily and check-out time is 3 p.m. daily.
- Campers are allowed one vehicle which can be used for transportation to be parked at a campsite. Additional vehicles must park in the visitor parking area.

Also adopted:

 The gate at Sportsman Park shall not be locked. The gate will be closed at 10 p.m. and opened by 8 a.m.
