

**Regular City/School Election – Dallas County, Iowa
Tuesday, November 5, 2019**

The City/School Election will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019. All eligible electors of Dallas County are eligible to vote in the City/School Election as long as they are:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Iowa and of Dallas County
- At least 18 years old

An eligible elector must NOT:

- Be a convicted felon (unless voting rights have been restored by the president or governor)
- Be currently judged incompetent to vote by a court

POLLING HOURS: All polling places will be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

| Monday, October 21 | Regular City/School Election Worry-Free Postmark Deadline Mailed voter registration forms which are postmarked on or before today are considered on time to be pre-registered. |
| Friday, October 25 | Regular City/School Election Voter Pre-Registration & Absentee Requests Deadline Deadline to pre-register to vote. After today voters can register using Election Day |
