

**General Election – Dallas County, Iowa
Tuesday, November 3, 2020**

The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. All eligible electors of Dallas County are eligible to vote in the General Election as long as they are:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Iowa and of Dallas County
- At least 18 years old

An eligible elector must NOT:

- Be a convicted felon (unless voting rights have been restored by the president or governor)
- Be currently judged incompetent to vote by a court

Monday, August 31	Withdrawal, Objection & Substitution Deadlines Office open until 5 p.m.

Saturday, October 24 8 a.m. -5 p.m.	Auditor's Office Open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Voter Pre-Registration Deadline & in-person absentee voting. (After this date, new county voters must use Election Day Registration procedures)
Friday, October 30	Absentee Challenges Deadline Last day to submit written challenges to the qualifications of an absentee voter. Office Open until 5 p.m.
Saturday, October 31 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.	Auditor's Office Open 8:00 a.m. to 5 p.m.
Monday, November 2 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.	Auditor's Office Open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Absentee Ballot In Person Deadline Last day to vote an absentee ballot in person at the Auditor's office.
Tuesday, November 3	Election Day – MUST vote at polling location ONLY! 7 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.
Wednesday, November 11	Veteran's Day – County Offices Closed
Tuesday, November 10	County Canvass of Votes Unofficial results are presented to the Board of Supervisors who review and compile election results from all precincts and makes the official report of the outcome of the election within the county
Friday, November 13 8 a.m.-5 p.m.	Recount Request Deadline Auditor's Office Open Until 5 p.m.
